










Supporting Literacy Through eTwinning


Arriving by Train

The hotel is approximately a 15 minute walk from Newcastle Central Train Station.









Arriving by Airplane

The airport is approximately 30 minutes travel from the hotel.

You will need to get the Metro "Green Line" to Gateshead station, and then walk 10 minutes.

You will need to purchase an "All Zones" single journey ticket which will cost £3.30. If you expect to use the Metro two or more times in a single day you can buy a "Day Saver" ticket.


Taxis are available without pre-booking. Cost from airport to hotel will be approximately £25-30. Journey time by taxi will be 20 minutes


